### English

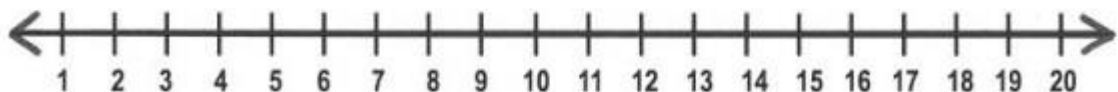
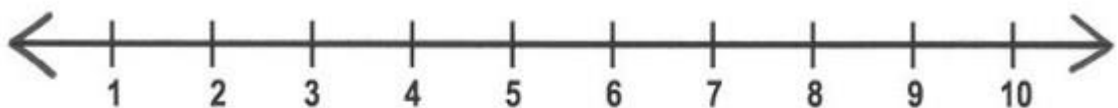

### Maths

- Practice and revise addition and subtraction tables.
- This week we will revise operations - remember when adding or subtracting always start with the units before moving to the tens and look at the sign carefully to see if you are supposed to be adding or subtracting.
- This topic can be tricky for some so it would be a great idea to draw out a numberline if needed to help count backwards and forwards.



- We would often use dienes blocks as well in the classroom when adding or subtracting. It might be an idea to have concrete materials on hand like bottlecaps or pencils etc so they can physically manipulate objects to enhance their understanding.
