Thanks to all that are sending on their work, great to see.

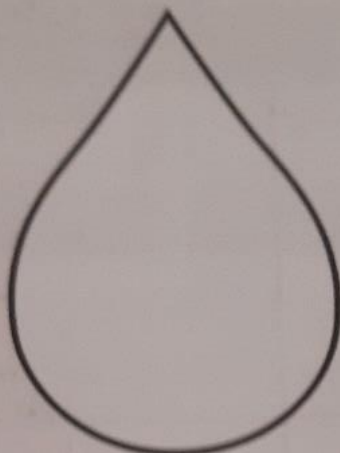
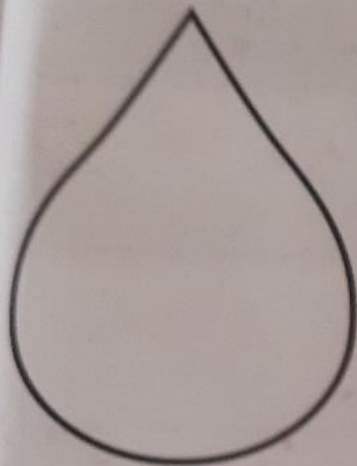

Rain

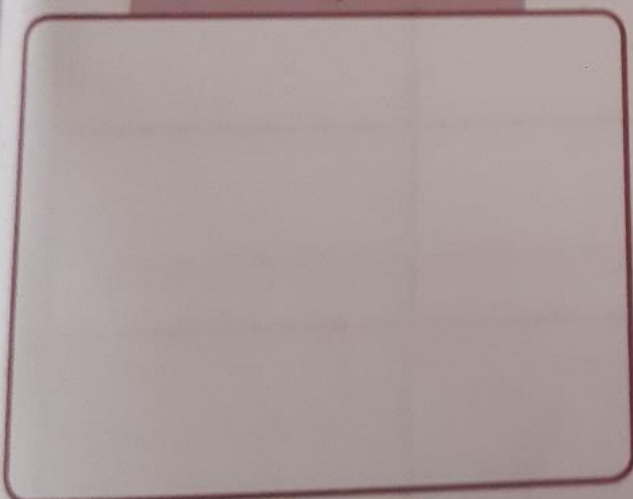


How do we use water?
Draw a use for water in each raindrop.

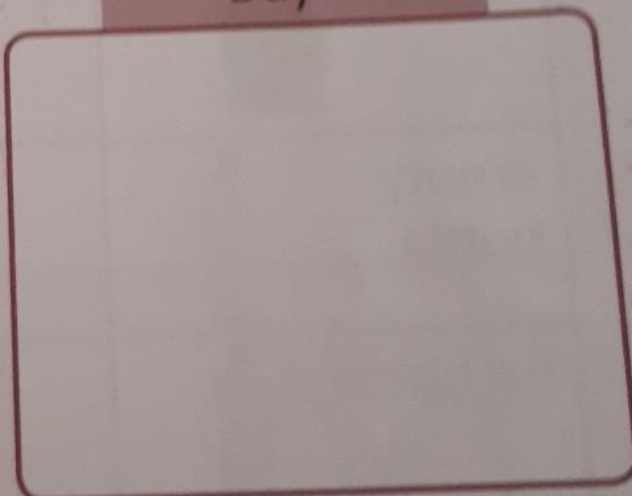


Draw your rain gauge on Day 2 and Day 5. What do you notice?

Day 2

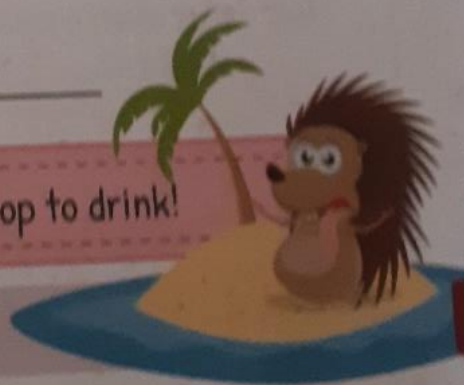


Day 5
